The Private Fleet Market Defined

- Trucking accounts for 80% of the nation's freight bill.
- Trucking accounts for 78% of all freight transported in the U.S.
- Private fleets account for 1/2 of trucking's share
- 1.8 million motor carriers operating in the U.S. (44% private carriers)
- Parent company's primary business is non-trucking (manufacturing, distribution, supplier, retail & wholesale)



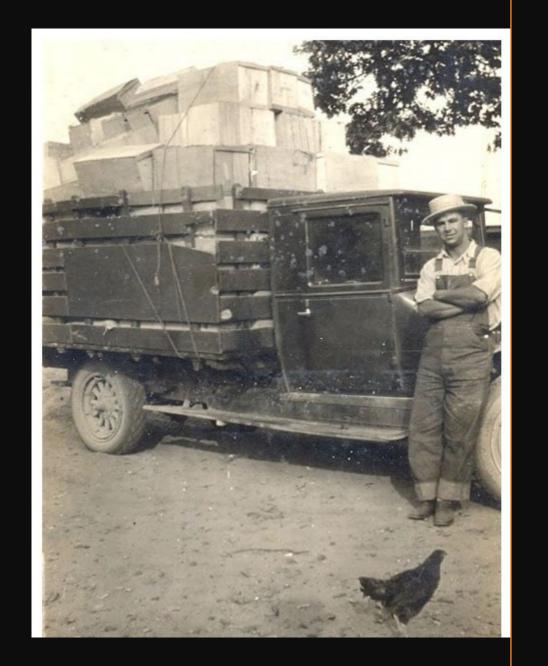

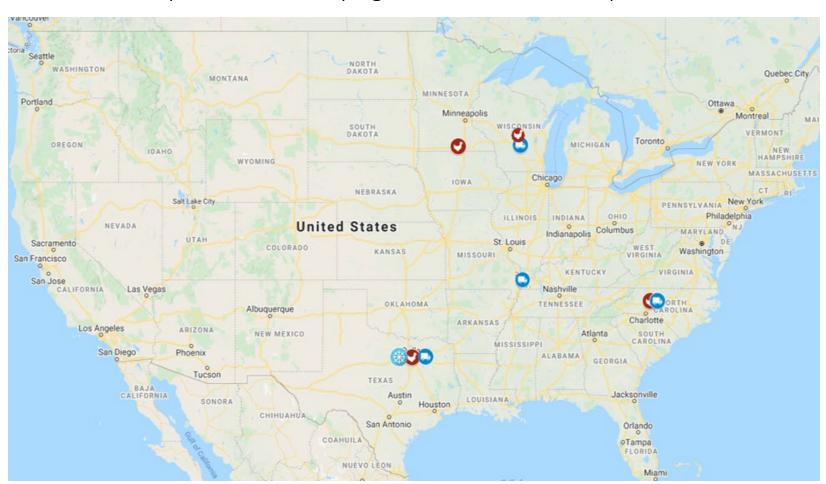

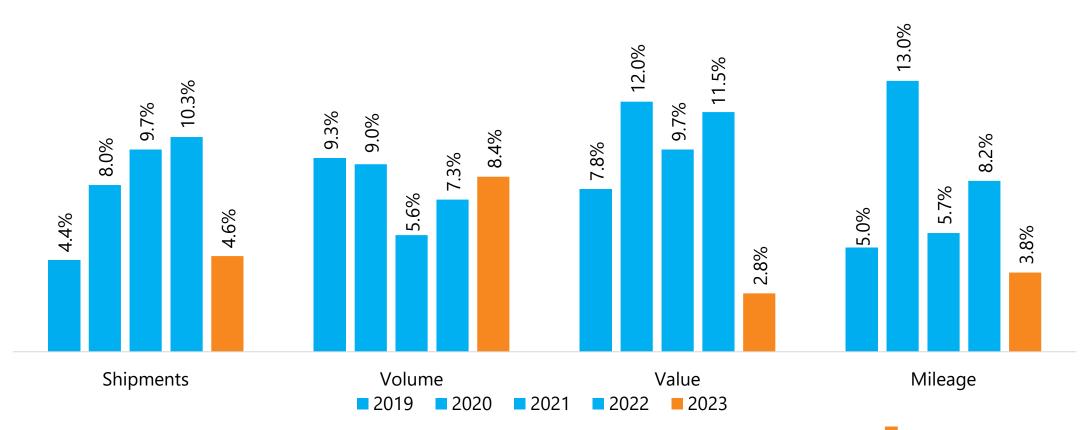

The private fleet provides flexibility to enhance the control of the supply chain and satisfy customer demand — safely, efficiently, and cost-effectively.

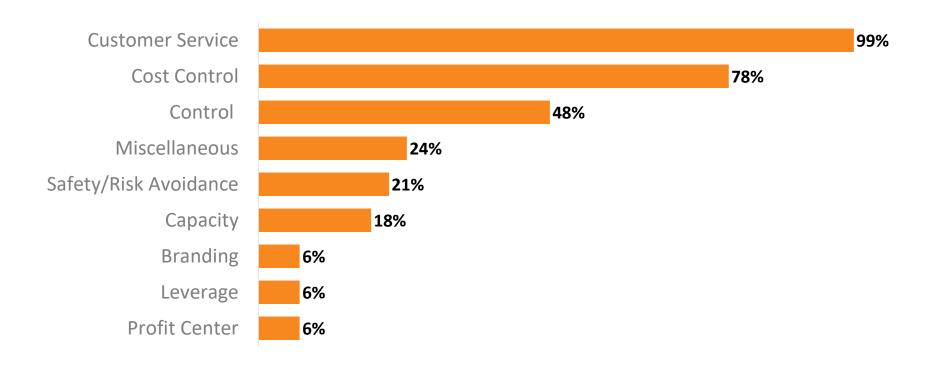

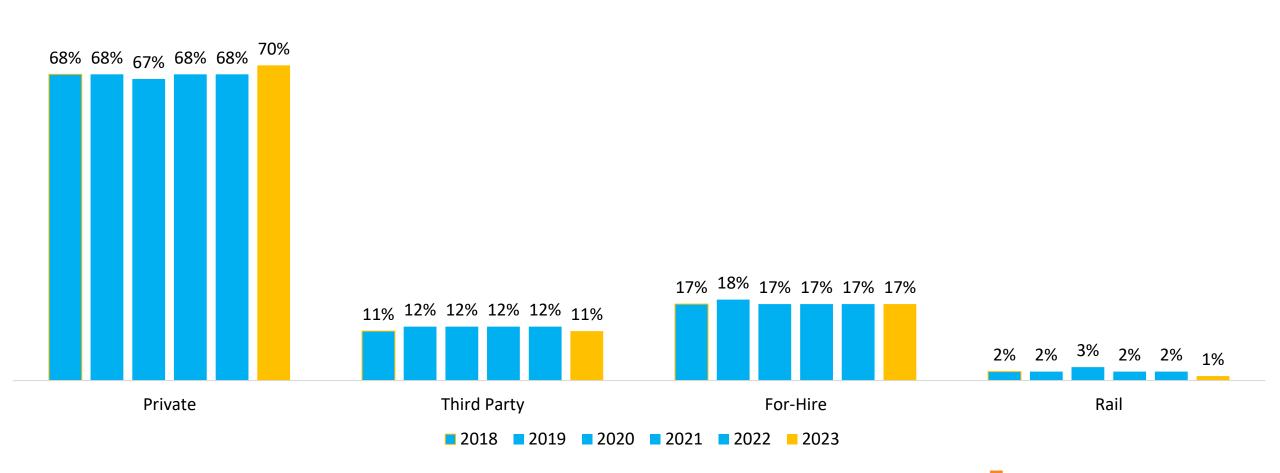

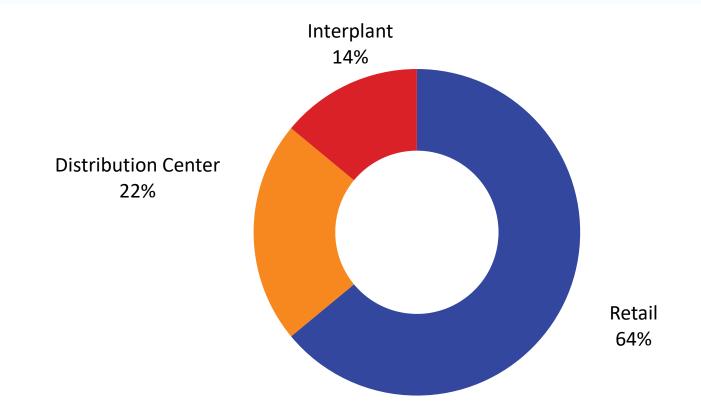


Outbound Transportation



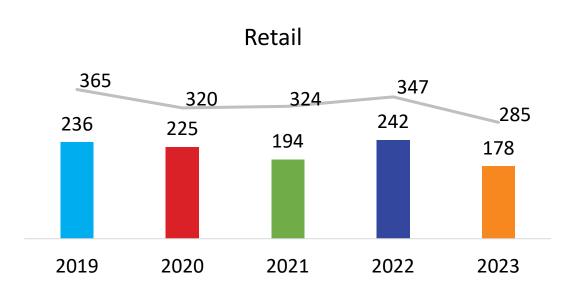


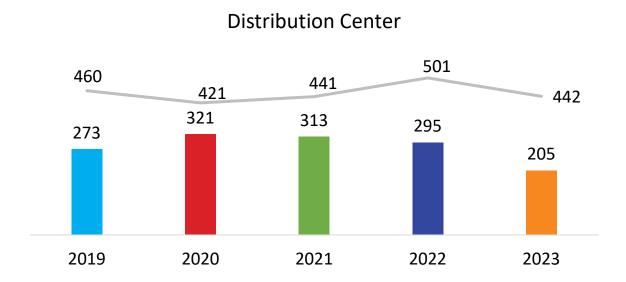
Private Fleet Outbound Movements





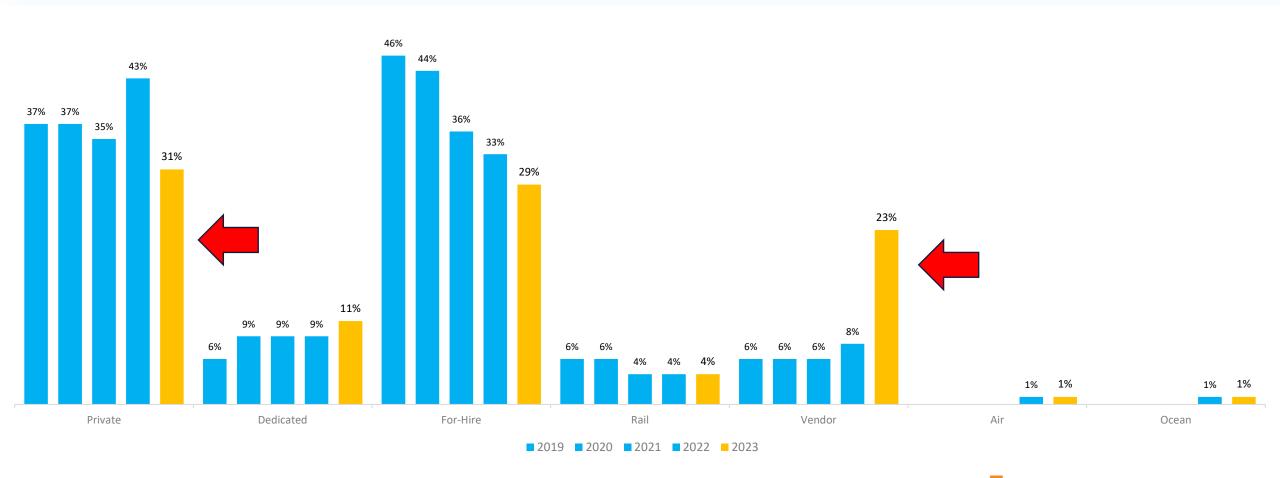
Length of Haul Characteristics





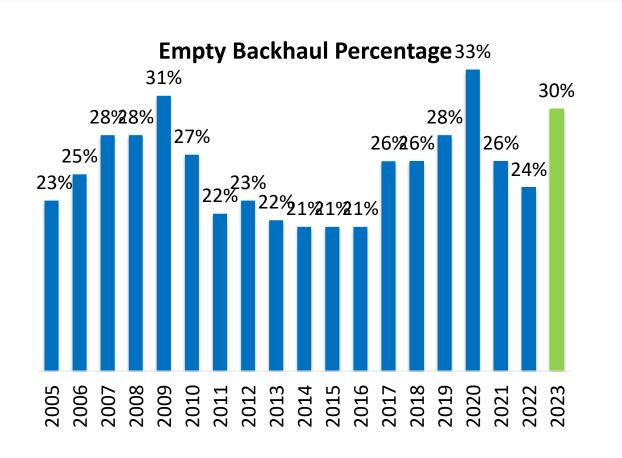


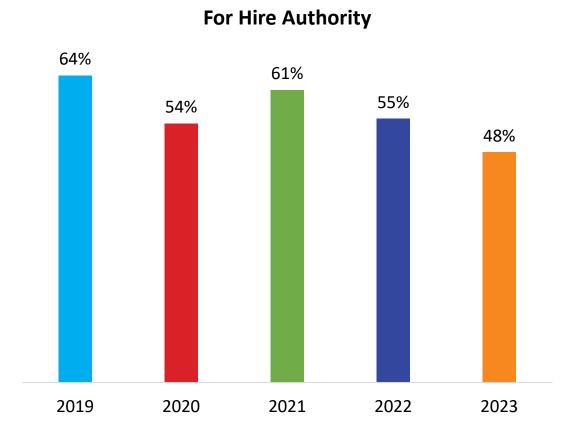
Inbound Freight Movements





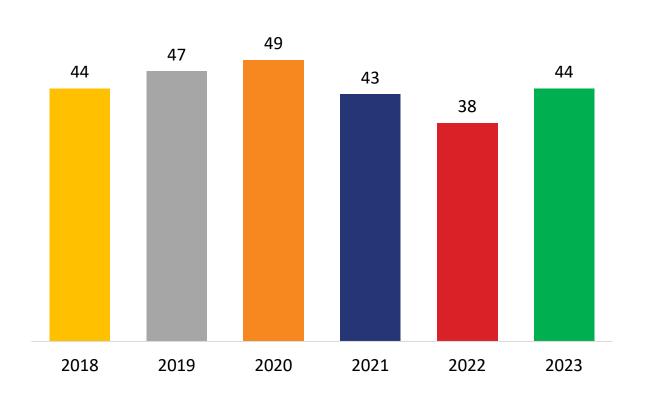
Empty Backhaul Percentage

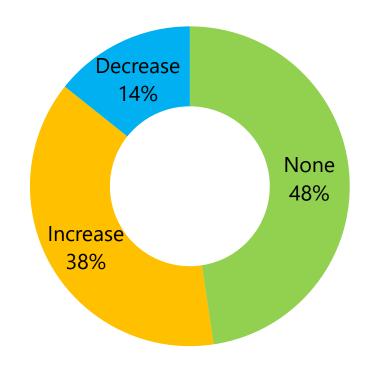






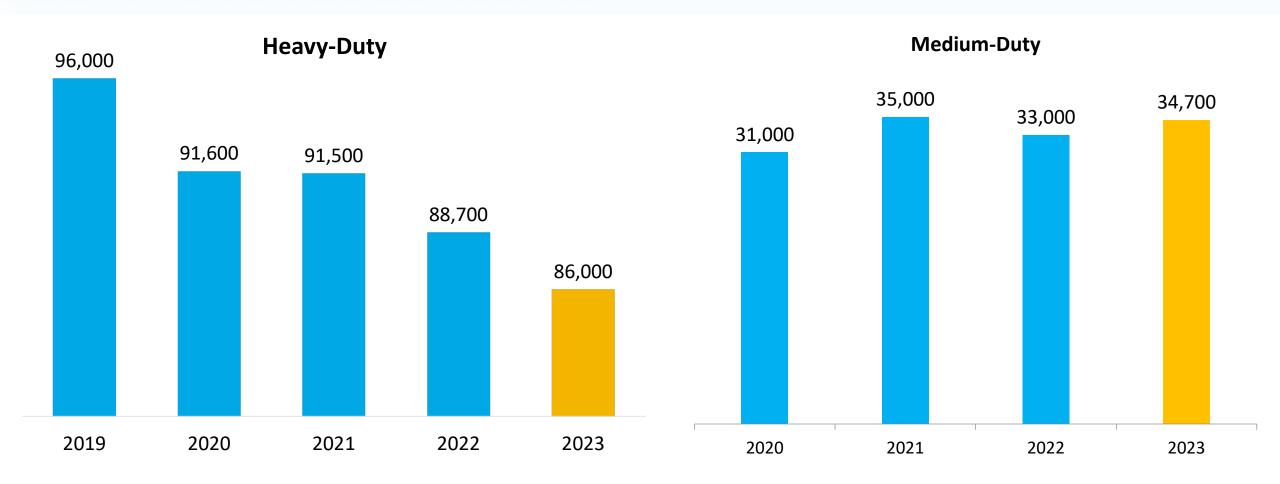

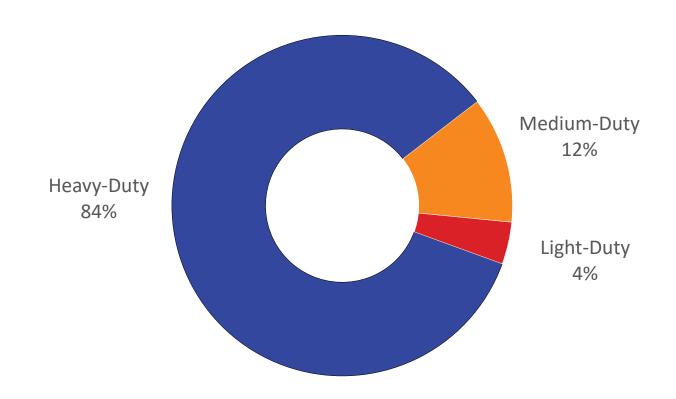
Annual Mileage





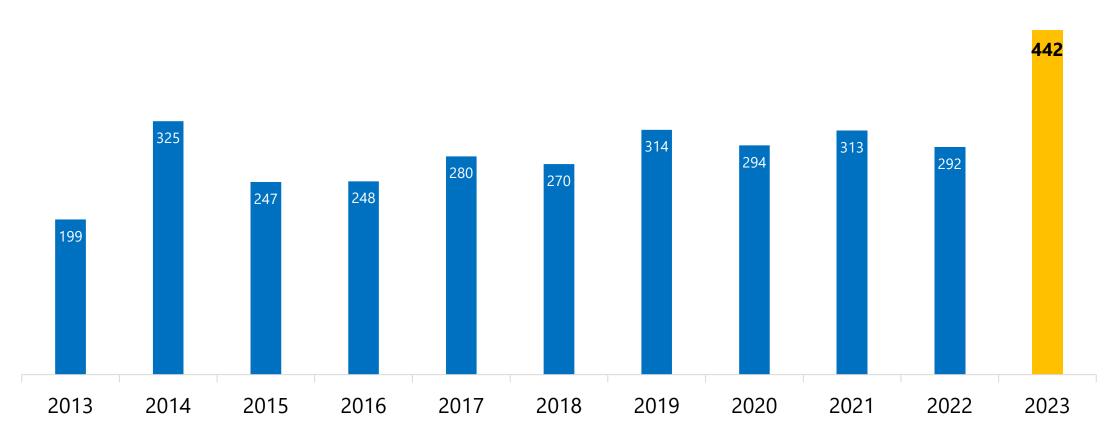

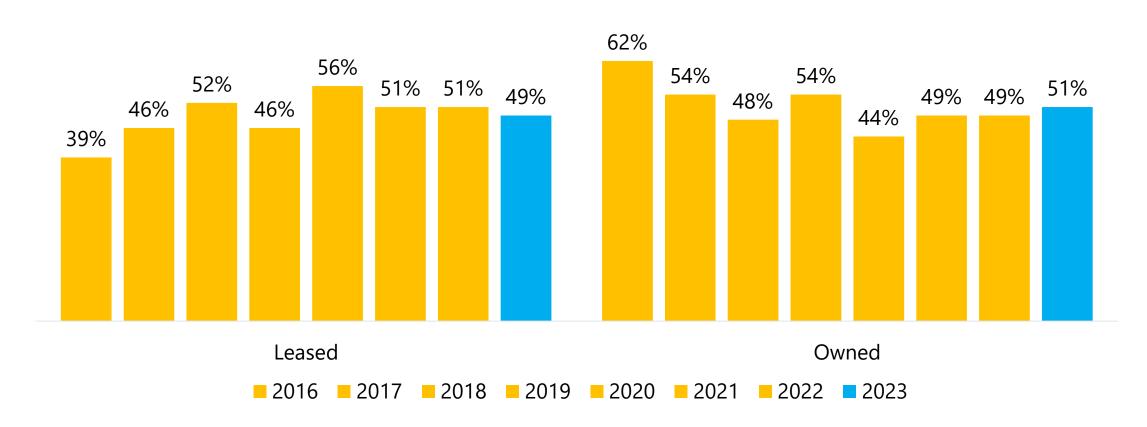

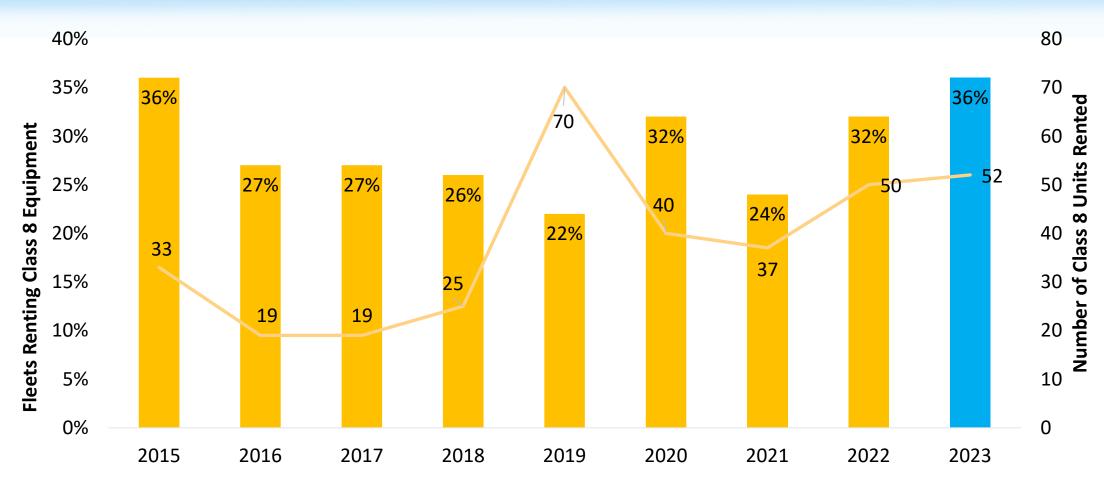


Lease vs. Buy: HD Population



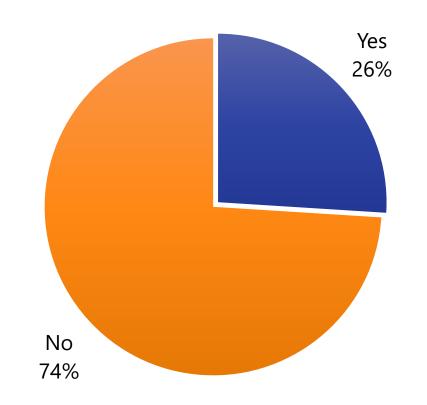

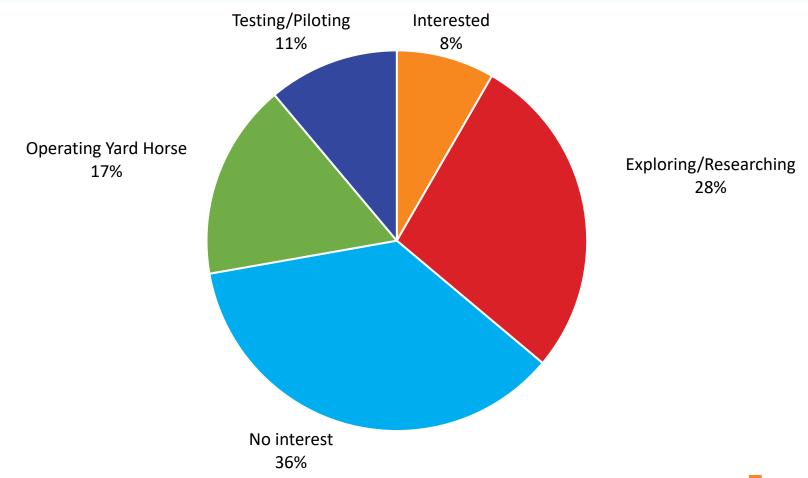


Diesel Dominates Power

- Average MPG = 7.39 MPG
- Alternative power plants comprise a small but growing portion of the overall market
- 17% report that a portion of their fleet is powered by a fuel source other than diesel (more than double year-over-year)
- 4.7% of all Class 8 vehicles are alternatively powered (1.7% last year)
- 14% of Medium-Duty fleets indicate use of such alternatives
- 11% of all Medium-Duty equipment is alternatively powered

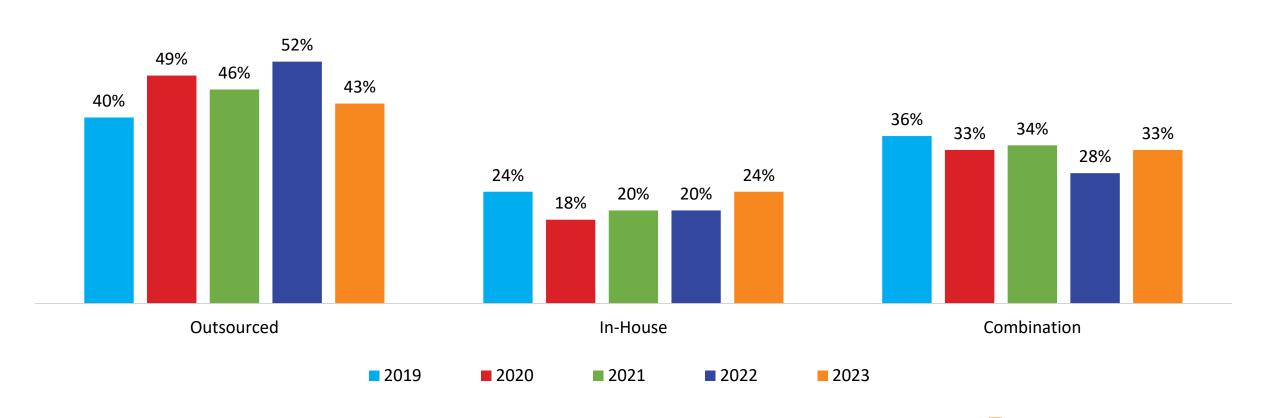

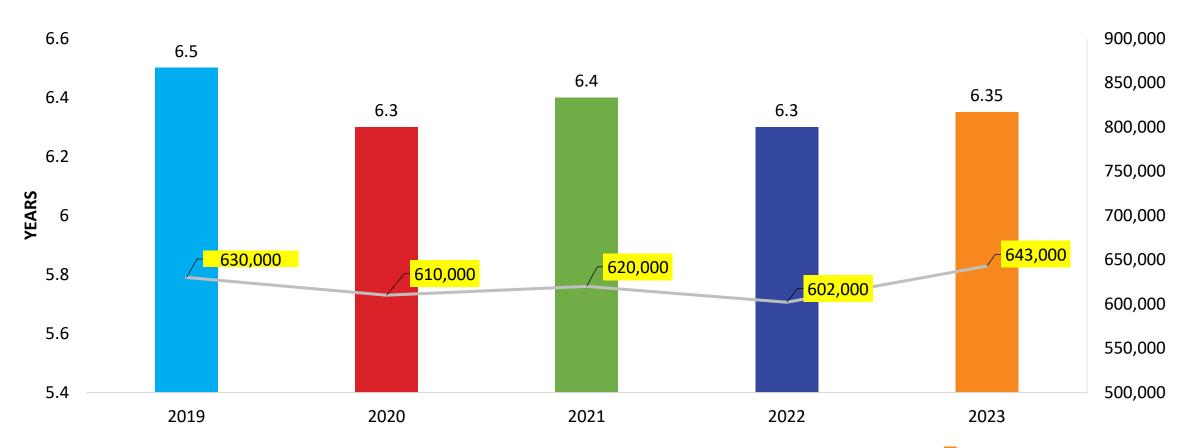


Where Is Maintenance Conducted?



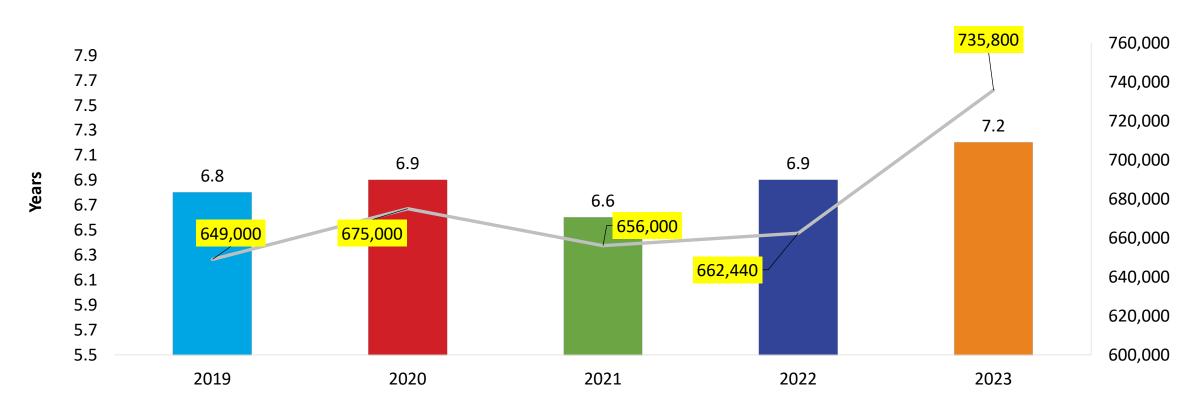


Class 8 Trade Cycles



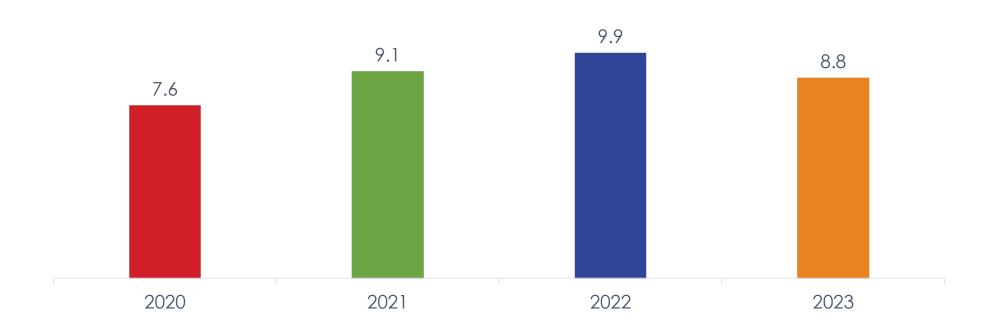


Class 8 Trade Cycles Leasing Removed



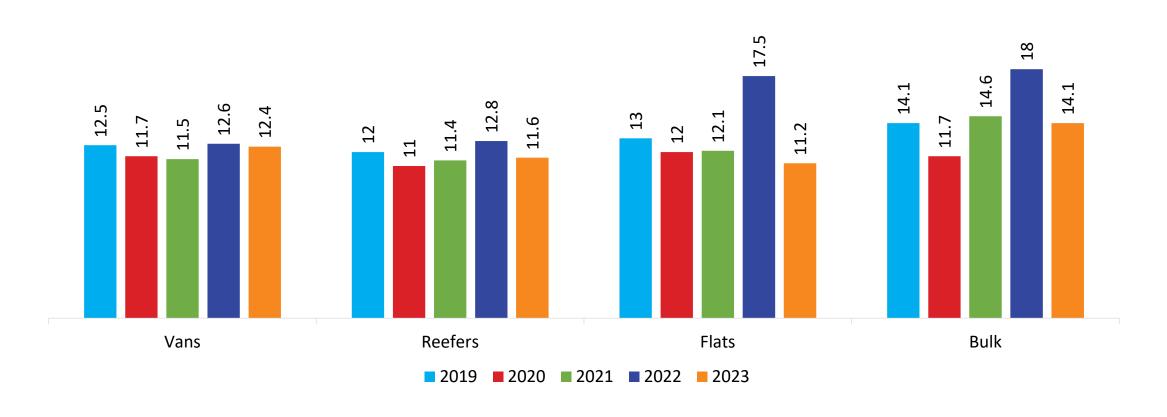


Medium-Duty Trade Cycles





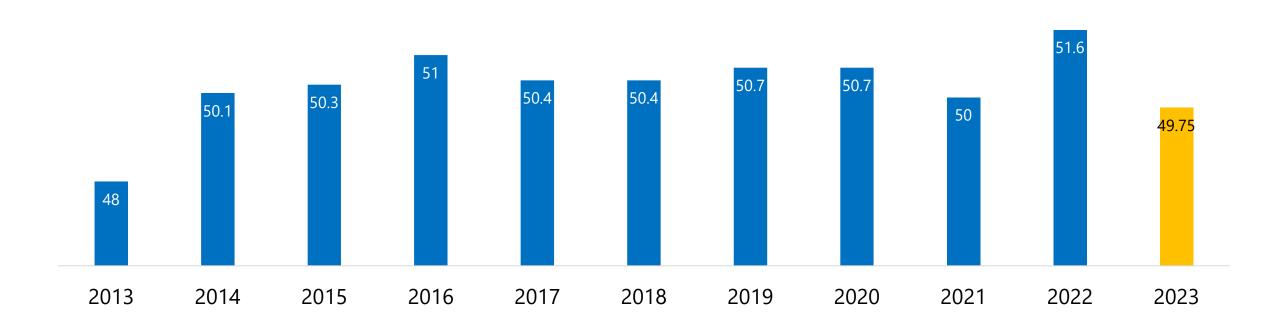
Trailer Trade Cycles





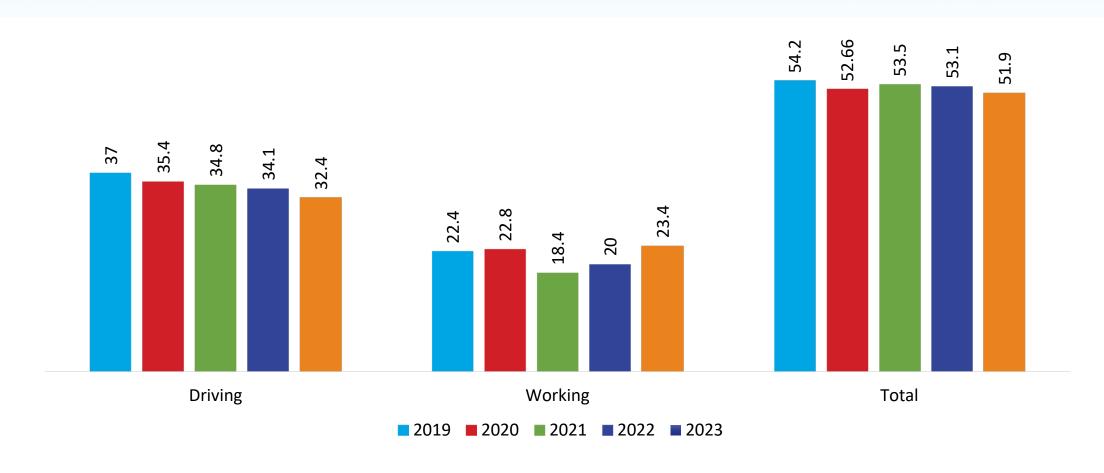

The Aging Driver Workforce



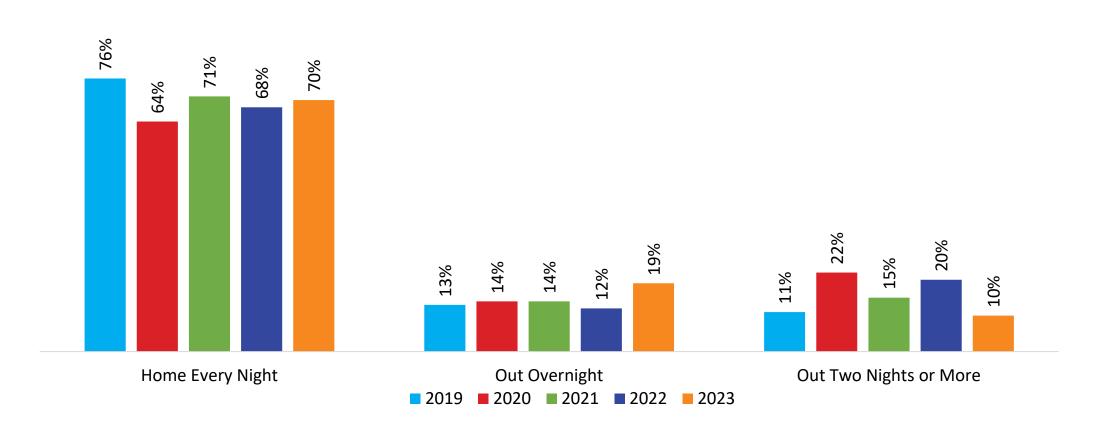


The Typical Driver's Work Week



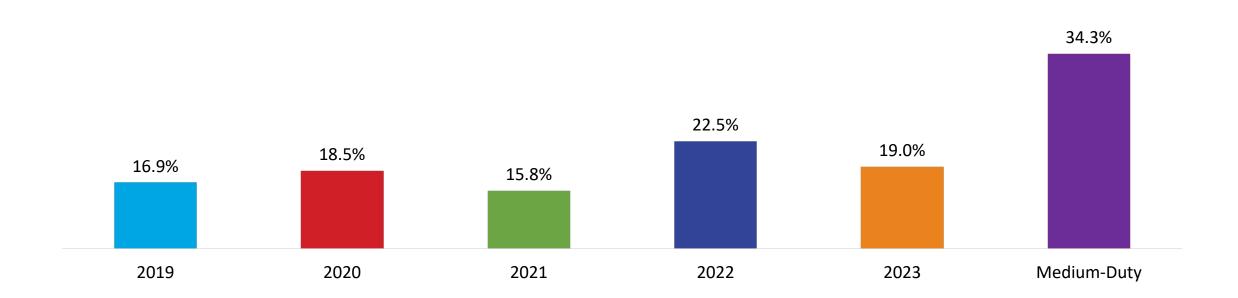

Average Cost of Turnover = \$9,748

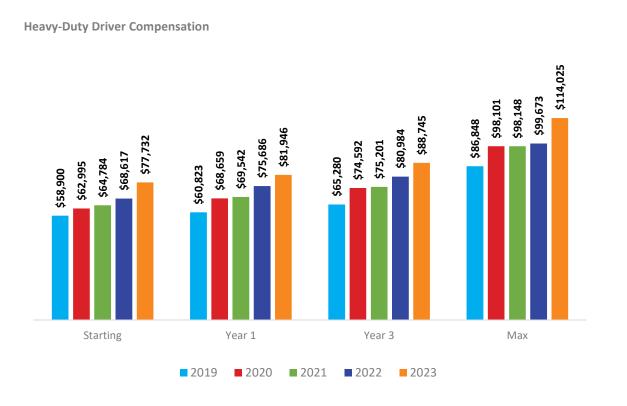


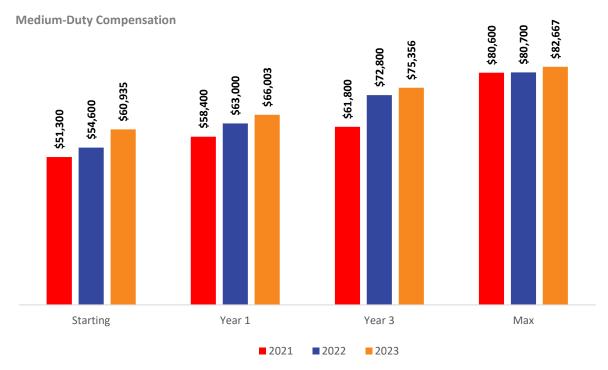
Average Driver Compensation





Compensation Levels



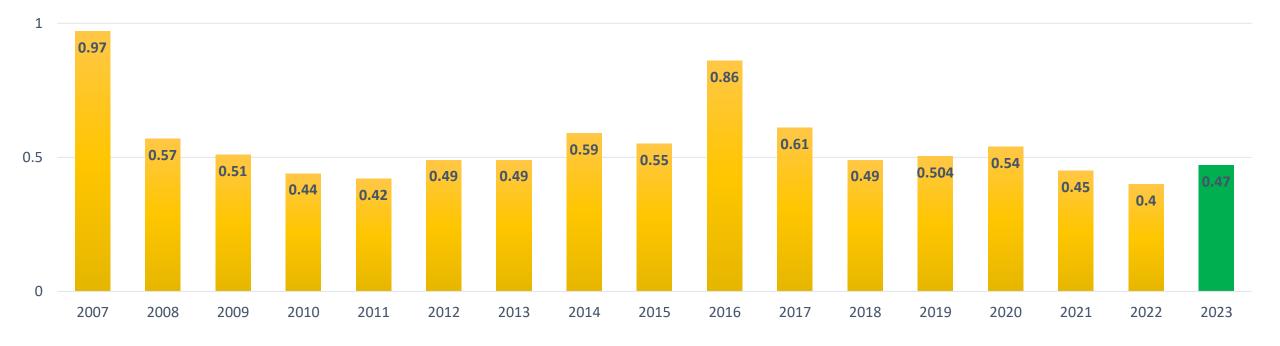

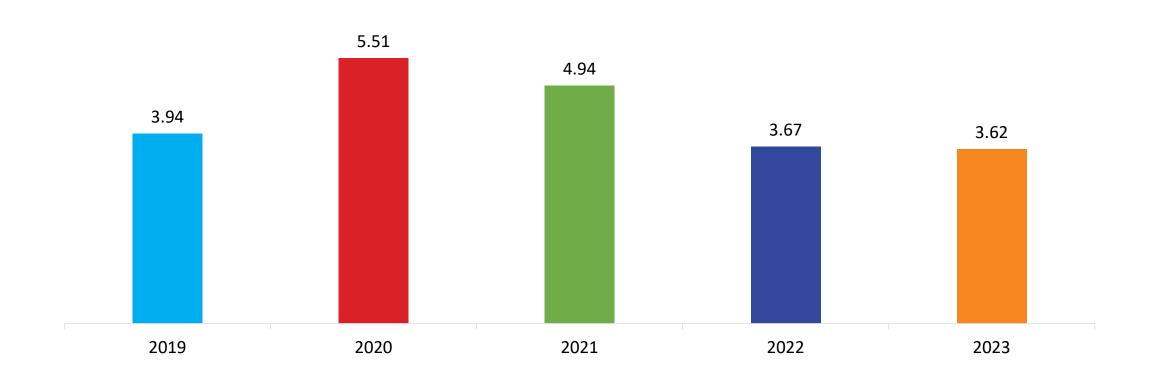


DOT Recordable Accidents
